Job Responsibilities

- Maintain the e-bike fleet: This includes any and all situations that may arise with any
 vehicle in the fleet. Included all maintenance both scheduled and triaged.
- Repair bikes: Repairing bikes is the main focus of this position.
- Other duties and responsibilities as needed

Desired Work Experience

- Must have some bike mechanic experience
- Skilled with tools- enjoys troubleshooting common problems and repairing anything that is broken, experienced supporting others in resolving repair issues.
- Highly proficient using computers, smartphones and common office software tools
- Flexible and adept at communicating with staff in different types of roles using varied tools and styles (including in-person, Slack, Zoom, phone, text, email, etc.)

- Able to communicate and empathize effectively with people of all ages, abilities, races, cultures, and economic statuses
- Efficient and detail-oriented, with solid time and task management skills
- Thrives on maintaining routines, comfortable holding others to the same standard

Required Qualities

- Must be able to lift 50 pounds repeatedly

Job and Application Details

This position requires at least 2-3 weekly shifts and is on-location based work in Ithaca, NY.

This is a 10-20 hour/week position, starting at \$25/hour. Benefits include paid time off; a mobility package including Ithaca Carshare membership, bikeshare use, and TCAT bus pass; a SIMPLE IRA with 2% employer contribution.
